

Cattle Dipping Vats in Florida

From the 1910's through the 1950's, these vats were filled with an arsenic solution for the control and eradication of the cattle fever tick. Other pesticides such as DDT were also widely used. By State law, all cattle, horses, mules, goats, and other susceptible animals were required to be dipped every 14 days. Under certain circumstances, the arsenic and other pesticides remaining at the site may present an environmental or public health hazard. See listing by county of known cattle dip vats.

The majority of the vats listed below are from old records of the State Livestock Board, which listed each vat as it was put into operation. There were also privately operated vats which may or may not have been listed by the Livestock Board, so this list is not an exhaustive list of all cattle dip vats. Note that vat locations were only identified by ranch name and county, and that street address or geographic location information is not available. In addition, some county boundaries have changed since the vats were first listed.
