2011 – 2012 Resource Management Annual Report Executive Summary

Prescribed Burning and Wildfires

- FPS burned 70,239 acres - nearly 10,000 acres more than the minimum ecological target and 87% of the acres planned
- The number fire-type acres in rotation (not backlogged) increased 7.5%
- FPS conducted 317 prescribed burns
- 41 wildfires accounted for 6,250 acres (8.9%) of the total acres burned
- 77% of parks with acres planned conducted at least one prescribed burn
- 33 parks exceeded the minimum ecological target
- 11 parks met or exceeded their all-time high acres burned
- Two districts achieved 100% of their planned goals
- 1,404 acres were mechanically treated in 23 parks for habitat improvement or fuel reduction

Prescribed burns were conducted on 165 days during FY 11-12, well above the 10 year average of 140. While this is a noteworthy accomplishment, burn managers are utilizing less than 50% of the available days in a year, underscoring the fact that they cannot afford to miss a good burn day. The division was fully prepared for a strike team request from The Florida Forest Service, with 14 team rotations starting on April 15, but the fiscal year ended without a call to duty. The state was plagued with drought for much of the winter and early spring but toward the end of June Tropical Storm Debbie brought between 8 and 20 inches of rain over much of the state.

Exotic Plant Removal

- For the first time, invasive exotic plant treatments were recorded and reported using the Invasive Exotic Plant (IEP) database.
- The standardized reporting methods designed into the database provide greater accuracy and consistency than was previously available using a simple spreadsheet.
- The 6,409 “infested acres treated” reflects only areas that were actually occupied by exotic plants, instead of the much larger “gross area” reported in the past. Infested acres are calculated by the database based on the density and distribution of the infestation within the gross area.
- A total of 22,327 gross acres were “worked” or traversed in order to treat 6,409 infested acres; the two numbers in context provide a more accurate picture of the amount of effort needed to treat invasive exotics.
- A total of 140 parks reported treating exotics.
- Staff logged an additional 662 additional infestations into the database during FY 11-12, bringing the total number of recorded infestations from 4,848 to 5,510.
- The number of acres in “maintenance condition” declined by about 10% from the previous fiscal year, likely a result of more accurate surveys and the additional infestations that were mapped.
- Staff prepared and submitted 32 proposals to their local working groups, 23 of which were completed

For the first time since the division began collecting treatment data, staff at the park level were able to enter their own treatment data. By relieving the district offices of data-entry responsibility, the division hopes to improve data quality and inspire a greater sense of data ownership at the park level. The Invasive Exotic Plants Annual Report contained in this document is the first one to be produced by the new database.

Exotic and Nuisance Animal Removal

- 5,135 feral hogs were removed in FY 11-12, the highest number on record
- District Three removed a record-high 2,031 feral hogs, an increase of 19% over their previous record, followed closely by District Four who had their second-best year ever with 1,973 removed.
- Contractors and volunteers were responsible for 36% of all animals removed; park staff removed the remaining 64%.
- An all-time high of 58 coyotes were removed, a 35% increase over last year's previous record of 43

The division continues to benefit from its excellent working relationship with USDA Wildlife Services for protecting nesting marine turtles and shorebirds from predators such as coyotes, raccoons and feral hogs. In addition to the federal assistance, FPS currently maintains eight contracts with private hog trappers in four districts to assist with feral hog control efforts. In October the Bureau of Natural and Cultural Resources completed an ongoing project to construct 78 hog traps which were built and delivered to 30 parks in all five districts. This combination of resources together with the diligence of park staff all contributed to the record-high number of feral hogs removed in Fiscal Year 2011-12.

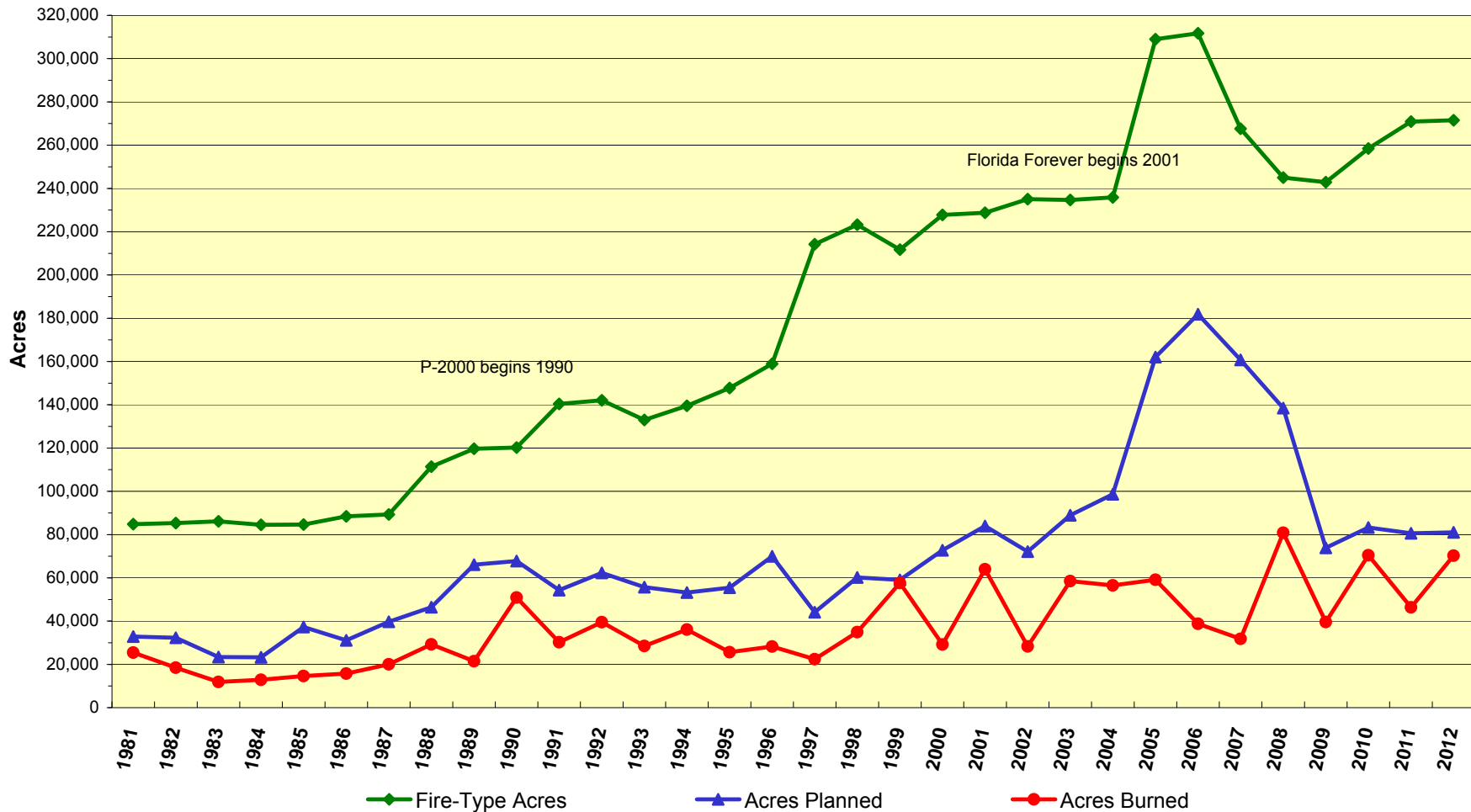
Marine Turtle Nesting – Calendar Year 2012

- 5,953 total nests were reported, the highest number on record
- An all-time high number of Loggerhead nests were recorded (5,337)
- A record-high number of Leatherback nests (145) were reported for the third consecutive year
- Roughly 107 miles of state park beaches were surveyed in 39 parks
- More than 1,000 nests were damaged by erosion from tropical weather systems
- Nest depredation increased slightly (from 8% to 9%) over last year

The record number of turtle nests in state parks was even more remarkable considering the large number of nests lost to erosion due to tropical weather systems Debby and Isaac. Predator control continued to be a challenge, with 13 of 39 parks reporting nearly a third of their nests affected by predators. In many cases, the nests are not totally lost, but the negative effects of nest predators are still of serious concern. For the third year in a row, the Sea Turtle Conservancy generously funded predator control work in three state parks. Two years after the Deepwater Horizon oil rig disaster Perdido Key State Park staff continue to collect tar balls from the beach, often as much as 4 pounds per kilometer of beach.

2005: Fire-type acres under management increased with the addition Office of Coastal and Aquatic Managed Areas properties

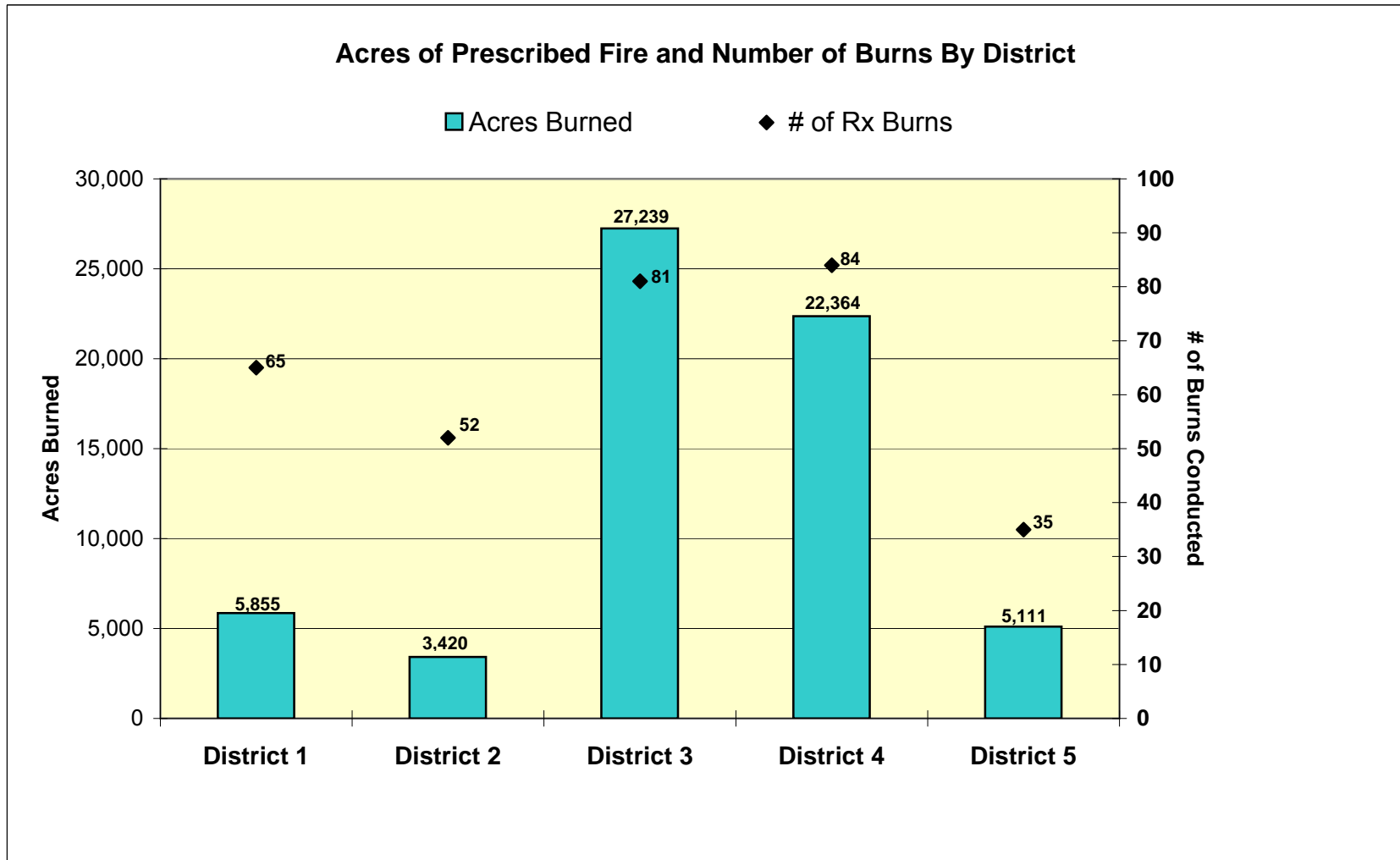
2005: Apparent increase in "Acres Planned" resulted from re-defining the plan to reflect ecological need rather than the operational plans

2009: Began tracking fire management accomplishments with new, more accurate database; resumed tracking operational plans rather than ecological objective

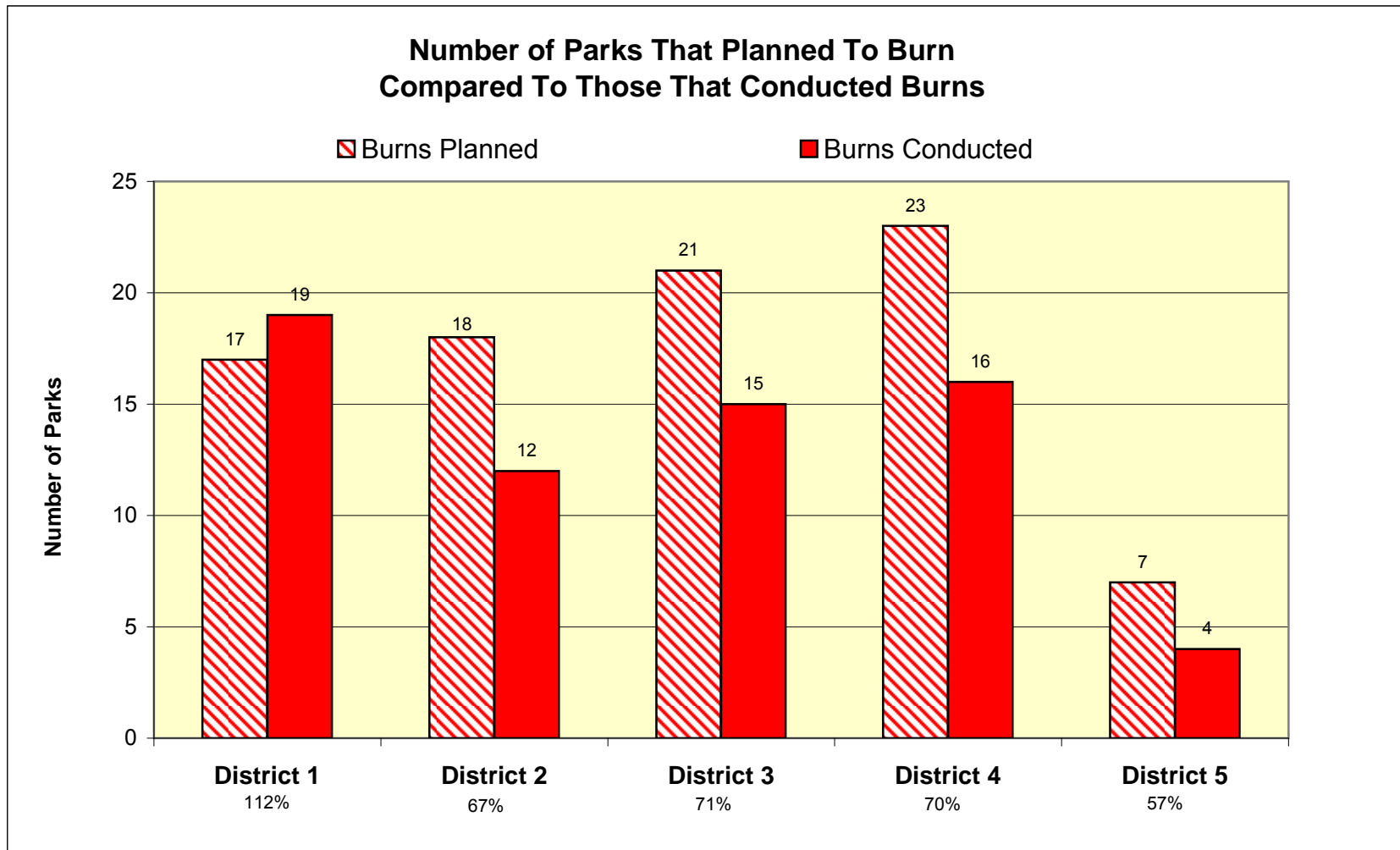

The graph below represents the total number of acres managed with prescribed fire (excludes wildfires) and the number of prescribed burns conducted in each district during the fiscal year.



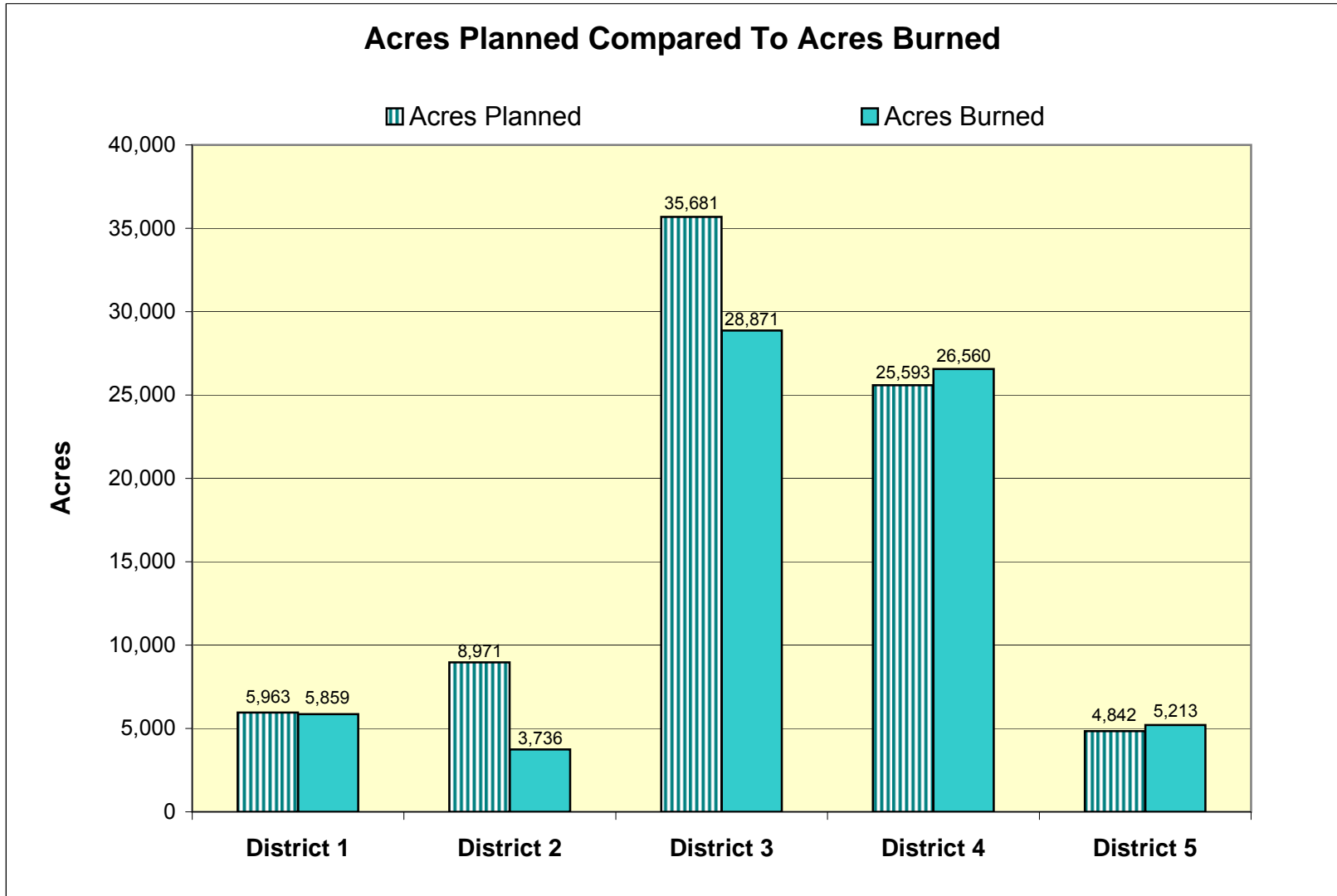

The graph below compares number of parks that planned to burn with the number that successfully conducted at least one prescribed burn during the fiscal year.



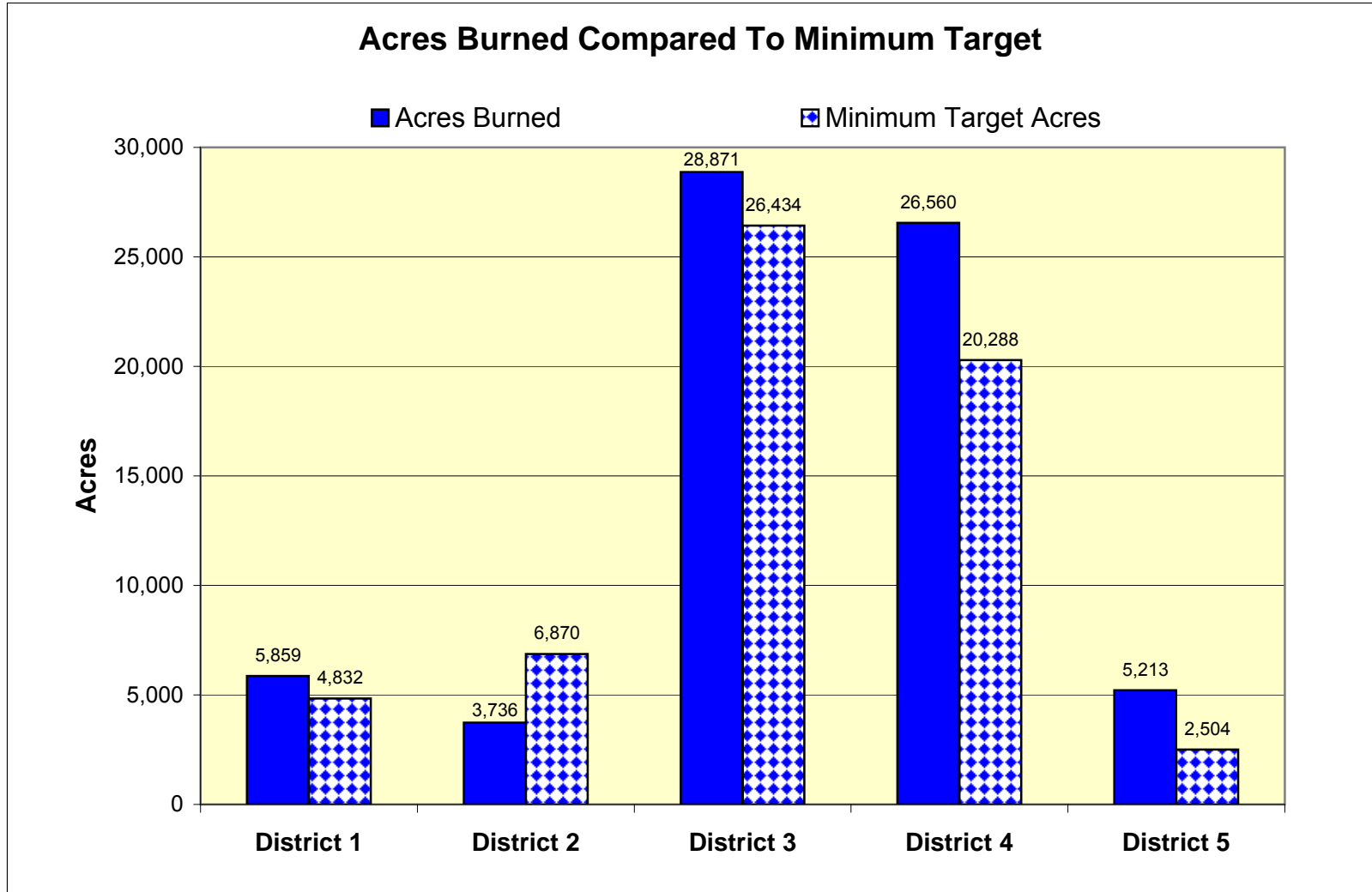

PLANNING AS OF JULY 1

- Fire-Type (FT) Acres:** Includes all natural communities where fire is an ecological process and any other zones being managed with fire.
- FT Acres in Rotation:** Fire-type acres that do not exceed maximum Fire Return Interval. That is, acres that are not backlogged. Formula: Fire-Type Acres less Backlog Acres.
- FT Target Acres:** Range of fire-type acres that need to be burned to remain in rotation. Formula: Sum of Acres by zone divided by maximum / minimum fire return interval.
- FT Acres Planned:** Fire-type acres in the fiscal year plan for burning. Formula: Sum of Annual Planned Acres.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS - ACRES BURNED (RX / WILDFIRE)

- Total:** Acres burned during the fiscal year, showing both prescribed and wildfire.
- Quarterly:** Acreage burned during each fiscal quarter, showing both prescribed and wildfire.
- Burn Count:** Number of prescribed fires and wildfires during the fiscal year. Each entry with a DOF Authorization counts as a single burn. Each entry with 'Day of 1st Report' for wildfire counts as one burn.

EVALUATION (Figures are performance indicators during the year and statistically valid on June 30.)

- FT Acres in Rotation:** Acreage that would be considered in rotation if no further burning for the fiscal year is done. Formula: Acres in Rotation (as of July 1) less acres that would become backlogged on June 30, plus acres burned during the fiscal year.
- % of Plan Met:** Percent of planned acres that were treated with fire. Formula: Annual Acres Treated Total divided by Acres Planned with a maximum value of 100%

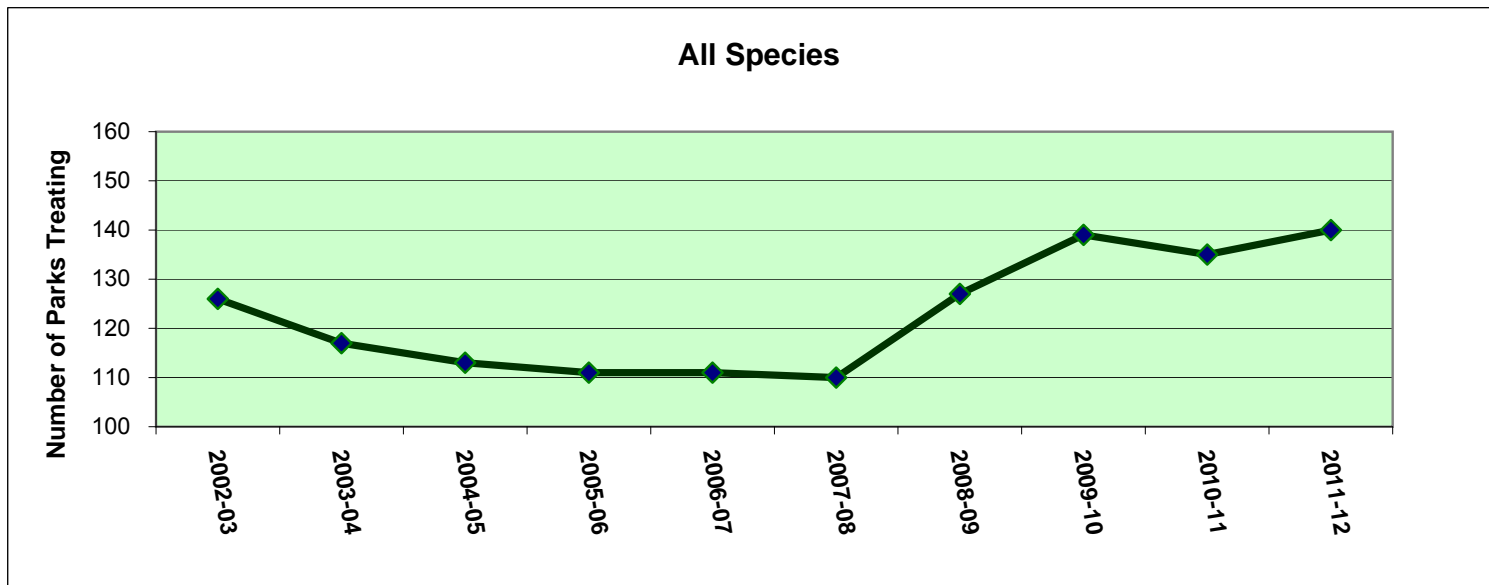
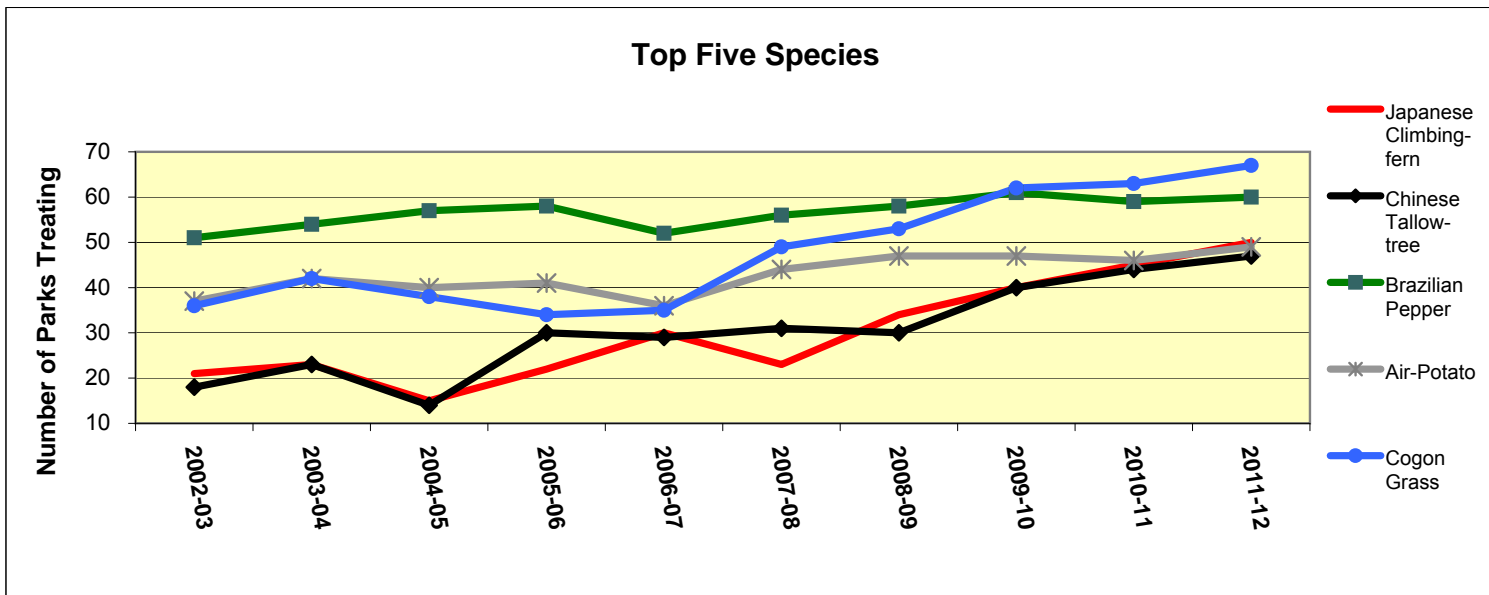

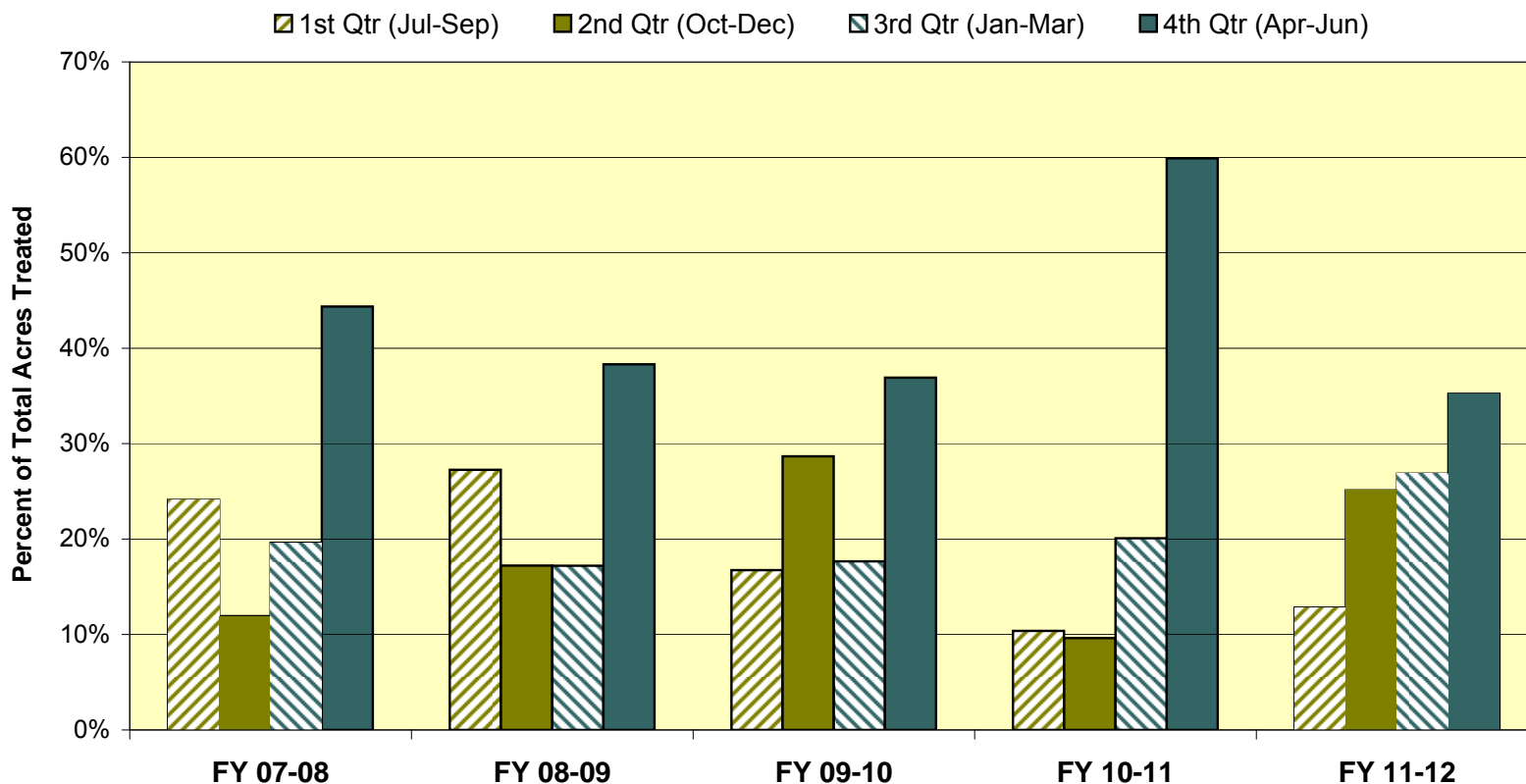

For the first time it has surpassed air-potato to become the 3rd most commonly removed species and, also for the first time, was treated in all five districts.

SUMMARY OF CURRENT CONDITIONS/PLANNING

- Total Park Acres:** The sum of the Management Zone acreages. This acreage may differ from the Division Jurisdiction Report.
- Acres in Maintenance Condition:** A field-based determination which should consider several factors. Generally, infestations in Maintenance Condition should: be manageable with existing staff and resources, not be expanding in size or percent cover, not contain large numbers of mature reproducing individuals, and not pose an imminent threat to imperiled plants, animals or natural communities. Additionally, any infestation that hasn't been surveyed within 24 months will fall out of maintenance condition.
- Gross Area (acres):** The general area occupied by one or more invasive exotic species. The area is estimated by imagining a line around the general perimeter of the infestation. The Gross Area may contain significant parcels of land that are not occupied by invasive exotic plants. Also interpreted as the total area that has to be worked to ensure complete treatment of the infestation.
- Infested Area (acres):** The approximate area of land covered by the invasive plants within a Gross Area if the invasive plants were accumulated into one area. Infested Area = Gross Area X midpoint of the Cover Class.
- Treatment Goals (Inf. Area):** The proposed area to treat (measured as Infested Area) established by the Park Manager as an achievable annual goal with the existing park resources or probable grants for the fiscal year.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS / INFESTED AREA TREATED

- Infested Area Treated:** Infested Area Treated (in acres) within each fiscal quarter (acres are not cumulative).
- Total Treated:** Sums, to date, the individual fiscal quarters for Infested Area Treated (in acres).
- % of Goal Met:** The percentage of the Treatment Goals accomplished at the time the report was generated.
- Gross Area Worked:** A running total of the Gross Area (in acres) that have been worked or traversed to treat the Infested Area.

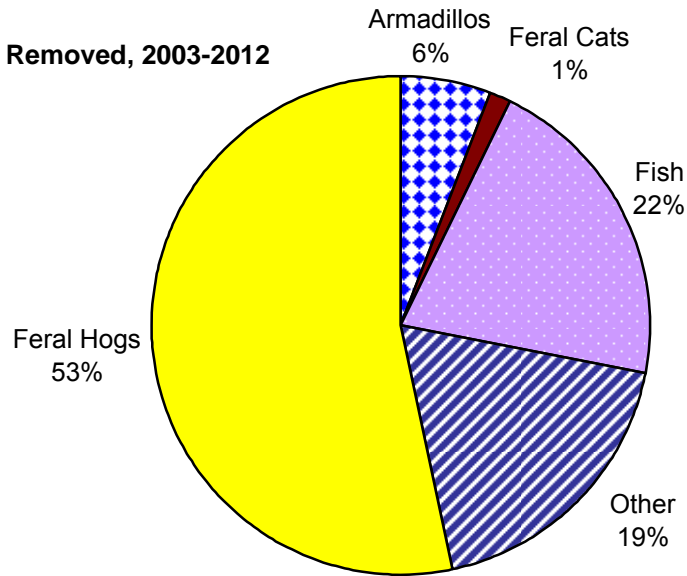

Animals Removed, 2003-2012

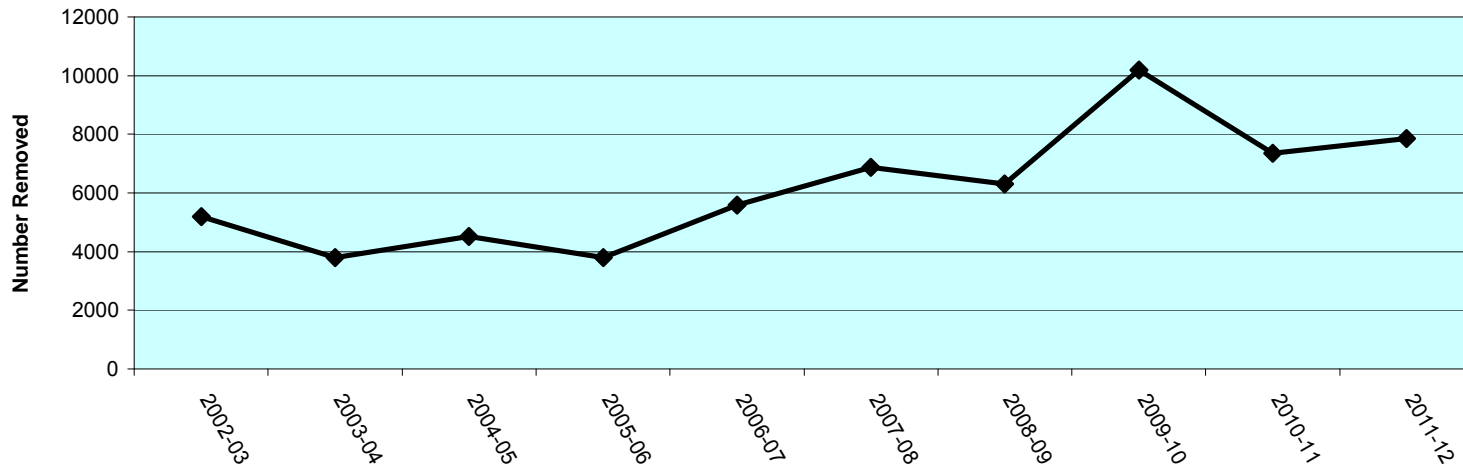

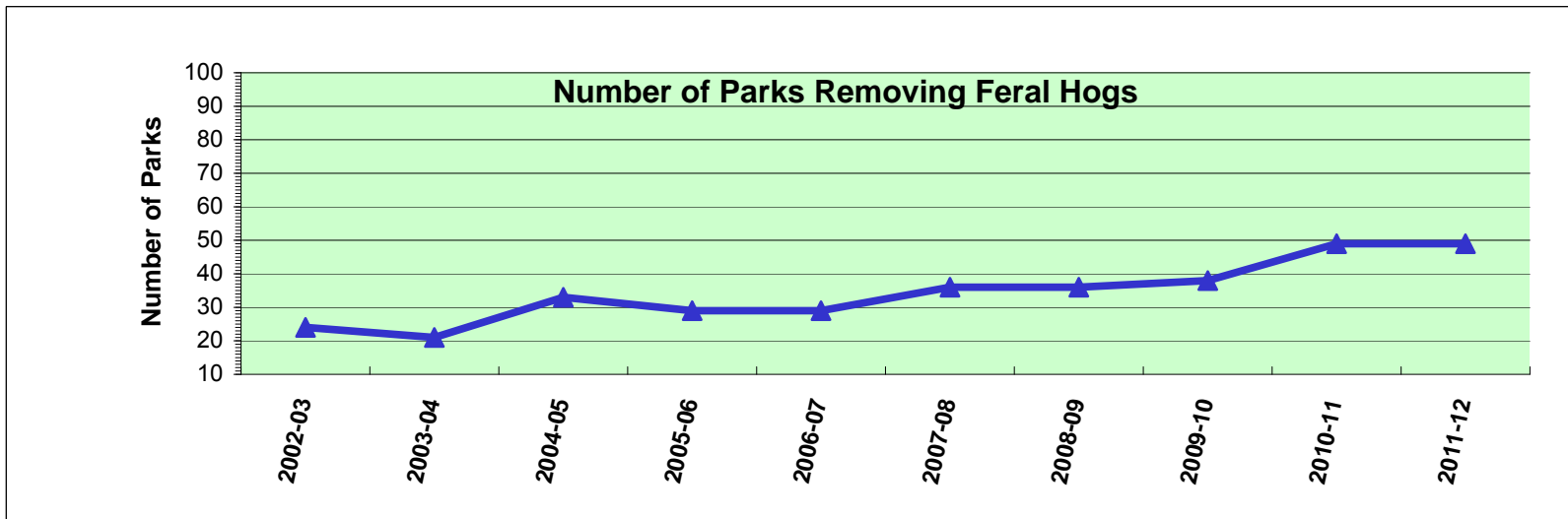
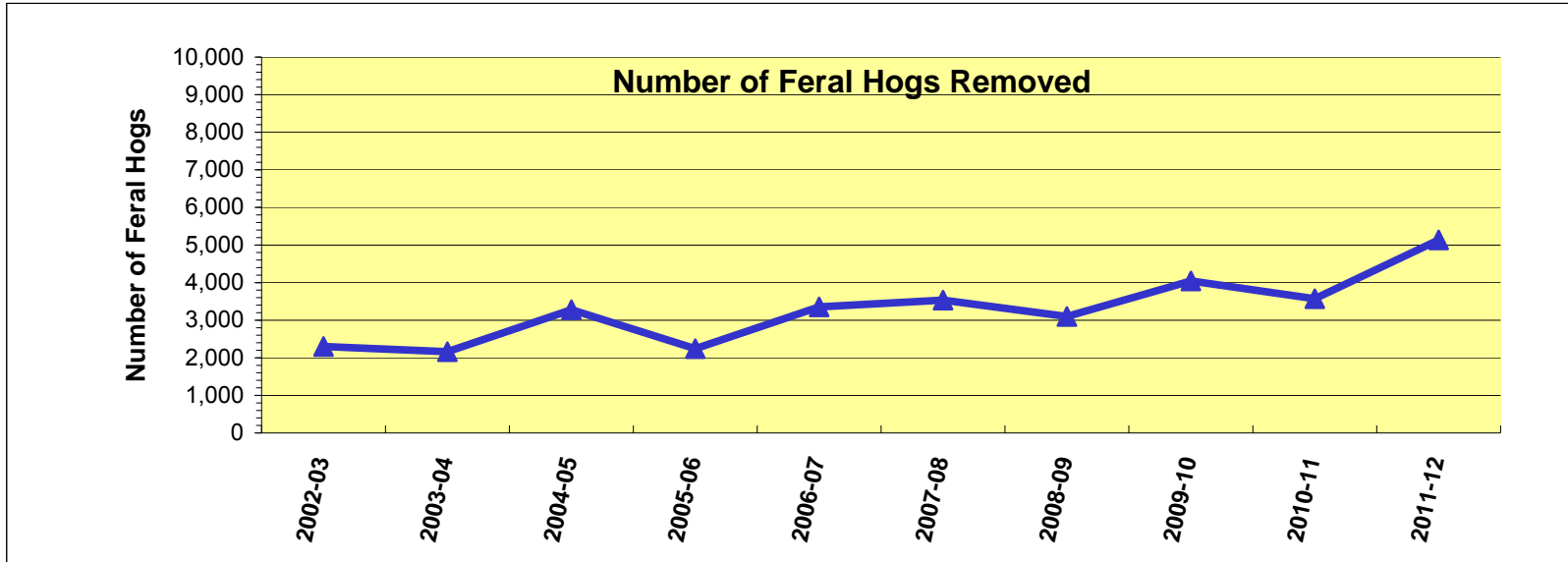

All Nuisance/Exotic Animals



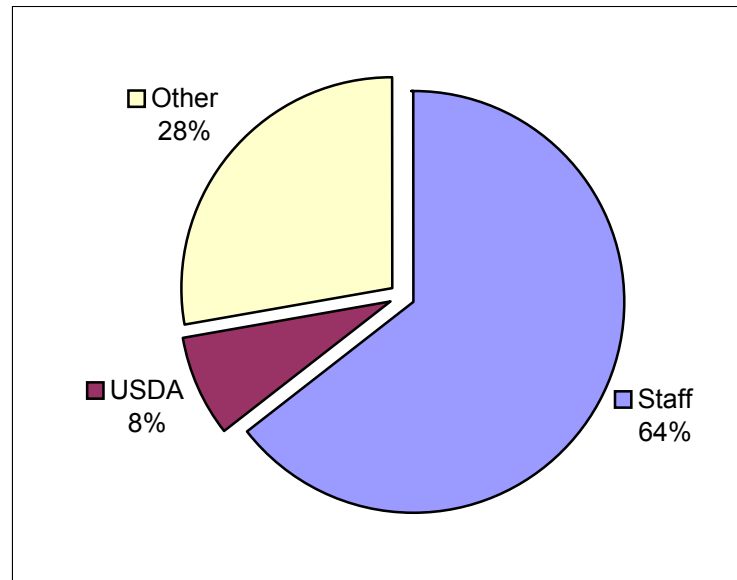
