In consultation with the Florida's Chief Resilience Officer, Dr. Wesley Brooks, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection's (DEP) Resilient Florida Program is pleased to submit the Florida Flood Resilience and Mitigation Efforts report required by Section 2, Chapter 2022-089, Laws of Florida.

Pursuant to Section 2, Chapter 2022-089, Laws of Florida, this report includes four components. The first component of the report is a list of local governments that are required to comply with the requirements of Section 163.3178(2)(f), Florida Statute (F.S.), but are not in compliance, as reported by the Department of Economic Opportunity. The second component of the report is a list of local governments that have completed a vulnerability assessment that comply with requirements of s. 380.093(3), F.S. Third, the report includes an overview of the geographic distribution of entities with projects funded through the Statewide Flooding and Sea Level Rise Resilience Plan ("State Resilience Plan"). In addition to projects funded through the State Plan, the report also includes information on projects funded through the Resilient Florida Grant Program using State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds. The final component of the report is a statewide inventory of basin-level flooding assessments and other related basin-level planning

efforts. These efforts were self-reported by water management districts or special districts authorized to submit projects pursuant to s. 380.093(5), F.S.
