**Background**

Ellie Schiller Homosassa Springs Wildlife State Park is a 200.25-acre property located in Citrus County in Homosassa. The park is managed by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Recreation and Parks (DRP).

**Improvements**

The following developments/improvements are proposed for the updated Ellie Schiller Homosassa Springs Wildlife State Park management plan:

- Renovate Visitor Center, Boathouse, and Boats
- Add Nature Trail connecting Use Areas
- Highlight the Mullet Train
- Reconfigure US 19 Park Entrance, Add Ranger Station, and Improve Traffic and Visitor Flow
- Improve Visitor Flow, Add Additional Parking, and Add Traffic Control for West Visitor Center
- Explore Fishbowl Renovation Options
- Remove Current Storage Building and Find New Storage Space
- Raise, Renovate, Expand Animal Habitats and Education Centers
