**St. Sebastian River Preserve State Park

Purpose

The purpose of this meeting is to receive public input on proposed 10-year management plan for St. Sebastian River Preserve State Park.

Background

St. Sebastian River Preserve State Park is a 21,629.35-acre property located in Brevard and Indian River Counties, near the communities of Fellsmere and Sebastian. St. Sebastian River Preserve State Park is managed by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Recreation and Parks.

Improvements

Developments/improvements are proposed for the updated St. Sebastian River Preserve State Park management plan include:

- Parking and access improvements and the addition of a restroom for Horseman Headquarters and Storytelling Camp.
- Improved parking, the addition of a restroom and access improvements for manatee viewing and fishing at the Manatee Viewing Area on the C-54 canal.
- Create a new paddling launch along the C-54 Canal to provide paddlers with convenient access to the North Prong of the St. Sebastian River.
