



ADVANCED CLEANUP (AC) PROGRAM

- 1. History: PreApproval Advanced Cleanup (PAC) thru Petroleum Restoration Program AC.
- 2. The three AC Programs.
- 3. Current Individual AC Process and LPs.



The PAC Program existed under PreApproval and allowed for the use of Inland Protection Trust Fund money on sites scored Below priority score funding rank.



- Discharge must be program eligible (EDI, ATRP, PLRIP, PCPP, etc.).
- Priority score must be below the funding threshold.



• The Property Owner / Responsible Party provided a 25% cost share toward the cleanup.

Cost share in "real" dollars with proof of payment to the contractor provided.



Applications were submitted 2x per year.

Applications included:

- •\$250 application fee.
- •Contractor Designation Form.
- Limited Contamination Assessment Report.



The Limited Contamination Report (LCAR)

- "Limited" not a full Ch. 62-780 F.A.C. assessment.
- Paid for by the property owner or responsible party.



- Typically, estimated cost to cleanup was NOT negotiated.
- Work orders used Preapproval Template Rates.
- Amendments were issued often.



HISTORY - AC NOT YOUR DADDY'S (OR MOMMY'S) PAC WHAT'S THE SAME?

1. The discharge must be program eligible (EDI, ATRP, etc.) and all eligibility requirements must be met.



WHAT'S CHANGED?

We have Applicants - Could be the property owner, or the responsible party, or some other "entity" (but not the ATC).



HISTORY - AC WHAT'S CHANGED?

- The Applicant must still provide a minimum of 25% of the Cleanup Cost.
- Now called the Applicant Share.
- Two ways to meet this AC requirement.



HISTORY - AC "APPLICANT SHARE"

1. Cost Share

Applicant pays a minimum of 25% of the cost to cleanup to the ATC (proof of payment required).



HISTORY - AC "APPLICANT SHARE"

2. Cost Savings A minimum 25% reduction in the negotiated costs based on Schedule of Pay Items (SPI).



HISTORY - AC SCORE IS NO LONGER A CRITERIA

Any Program Eligible site may apply for AC. Has this impacted any of you site managers? No Replacement Sites.



- Cost to Cleanup is negotiated.
- Contractor Recommendation Form has replaced Contractor Designation Form.
- AC Contingency now 10% (down from 20%).



MORE THAN ONE AC PROGRAM

- 1. AC-Individual sites-offspring of PAC.
- 2. PBAC-Performance Based Advanced Cleanup Bundles.
- 3. ACR-Advanced Cleanup for Redevelopment.



- Program requirements spelled out in Chapter 376.30713 F.S.
- All agreements must end in an RMO endpoint.
- Agreements (POs) may be up to 5 years.



- 1. AC Individual sites.
- Managed by LP Site Managers (usually).
- Line item/task SPI (usually).
- Multiple P0s.
- Retainage.
- Application Period 2x per year.



- 2. PBAC Performance Based Advanced.
 - Cleanup Bundles (5 or more facilities).
 - Managed by Site Managers on PRP-1.
 - Milestone (22-1.) SPIs.
 - Single PO.



- 3. PBAC continued.
 - 25% minimum Applicant Share Bundle.
 - Aggregate Total –sum of individual POs.
 - No Retainage.
 - Verification Sampling.



- 4. ACR -Advanced Cleanup for Redevelopment.
 - Statutory limit \$1 million/applicant/yr.
 - Single PBC PO Milestones.
 - PBC no Retainage.
 - No Applicant Share Required.



- Applications received 2x per year January and July.
- Application is a sealed competitive bid.
- Opening is announced and open to the public.



- A list of sites is sent to LP team to be added to LP task assignment.
- We put sites on a STCM hold.
- Only other sites that can go on hold are potential PBAC sites (18 month hold).



The LCAR - "LCAR-LIKE":

- LSA, LSSI, and historical data.
- Conceptual Plan.
- Data must support Application SOW and SPI.



Request additional "LCAR" data balancing act;

- Applicant must pay.
- We need data sufficient to negotiate cost.



Fiscal Review

- Does the SPI reflect the SOW?
- Only allowable costs.
- Only rates at/or below the negotiated
 ATC rates are allowed.



Fiscal Review

- Reviewer generates an SPI based on the Reviewer & ACWG technical review.
- This total cost is used to Negotiate the Cost to Cleanup with the ATC.



AC Working Group meets to determine;

- scope of work,
- estimated cost of cleanup,
- endpoint,
- time to completion.



Working Group contacts LP to discuss;

- scope of work,
- estimated cost of cleanup,
- endpoint,
- time to completion.



PRP-1 negotiates SOW and Costs with ATC. Agreement prepared once all Parties agree. Agreement routed for conceptual approval, Applicant & ATC signature, and final execution.



- Three Party; DEP, Applicant, & ATC
- Paragraph 8 specifies ceiling & Applicant Share



- 8A. Negotiated Cost to Closure.
- 8B. Contingency (10%) of negotiated cost amount applied after applicant share is removed.



8C. Applicant Share

Is it a cost share or a cost savings or both?

This determines the export Attachment B.



8C. In addition to AC Share, is there a PCPP Co-Pay? The 25% PCPP Co-Pay does not satisfy the AC Requirement.



8D. DEP Share

This determines the DEP Share to use when creating the SPI Quantities (usually 75%). This is the amount in STCM.



8E. Applicant Co-Pay – only for PCPP
The PCPP Co-Pay is not counted toward – the AC required 25% Applicant Share. A PCPP AC will have a minimum of 50% Applicant responsibility.

CURRENT AC PROCESS AC AGREEMENT

8F. Agreement Ceiling
The DEP Share + 10% Contingency
Original PO + any RFCs can NOT exceed this amount.



CURRENT AC PROCESS AC AGREEMENT

8G. Utility Costs

- Monthly utility costs are paid outside of the agreement (as with non-AC POs).
- These costs DO count against the CAP, so keep track of total amount spent.



CURRENT AC PROCESS AC AGREEMENT

8H. Cumulative AC Allocation For internal tracking of money spent against the money allocated for AC in a funding period.



CURRENT AC PROCESS - PR/PO CREATION

- ACWG Reviewer will prepare the SOW and sample SPI for the PR.
- Everything will be transferred to the managing team to complete the first PO.




- The SOW and sample SPI, along with site permissions will be transferred to the Local Program Site Manager.
- Note the share on used for sample SPI (usually 75%).




Type of Applicant Share

(Cost Share or Cost Savings) must be clear in SPI description and subject email to PR creator.

• PRP Team 1 will assist with PCPP sites and regular ACs with both a Cost Share and Savings.



- Include clear description -Indicate AC with Savings or Share as applies.
- All ACs are direct assign.




• DEP Share is simply DEP Share, regardless of type of Applicant Share. Usually 75%.



To get the correct Attachment B, Cost Share or Savings template download you must be clear on "Share".

This is savings download





Transferred information also includes;

- Executed Agreement.
- Application and LCAR.
- Reviewer Workbook and Review Summary.
- Executed Site Access Agreement.



Transferred information includes;

- Executed Agreement.
- Application and LCAR.
- Reviewer Workbook and Review Summary.
- Executed Site Access Agreement




- Site Manager should manage like any other site.
- Be sure to include line item field change \$.
- If 10% money is needed contact Grant or Dona for an increase in STCM ceiling.




- The agreement considers worst case scenario you do NOT have to spend it all.
- The LP Site Manager is the most familiar.
- Modify SOW based on your site specifics (i.e. No TRPHs, don't task FL-PRO).
