- 1. The Contract is extended for a 6-month period, pursuant to section 287.057(13), F.S., to begin August 14, 2024, and remain in effect until February 14, 2025. The Department and the Contractor shall continue to perform their respective duties during this extension period pursuant to the same terms and conditions provided in the Contract.
- 2. Paragraph 4, Term of Contract Section C is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - C. No new Purchase Orders or Task Assignments shall be issued or executed after the Term of Contract. However, the Restated Contract shall continue in effect up to twelve months after the extended term for completion of any Purchase Order or Task Assignment issued/executed during the renewal or extended term. Purchase Orders or Task Assignments, completion of which extends beyond the extended term shall continue to be subject to change, as appropriate.
- 3. All other terms and conditions of the Contract remain in effect. If and to the extent that any inconsistency may appear between the Contract and this Amendment, the provisions of this Amendment shall control.
