I. Cooperative Agreement Overview

The Florida Department of Environmental Protection's (FDEP) CERCLA Site Screening (CSS) team works within the Brownfields and CERCLA Administration subsection and conducts research and assessments of sites with confirmed and/or suspect contamination for the U.S Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Superfund program. Currently, the EPA provides funding for this work through Cooperative Agreement (CA) Number V-00D57717, which allows FDEP to perform site assessments including prescreening evaluations, abbreviated assessments, reassessments, preliminary assessments with or without sampling, and more detailed site inspections including sampling.

On August 16, 2017, the FDEP was awarded a total of \$631,340 for a two-year period from October 1, 2017 to September 30, 2019 via CA V-00D57717. This CA, which amounts to \$313,220 for fiscal year (FY) 2018, and \$318,120 for FY 2019. A portion of the FY 2018 monies (\$172,271 or 55%) was released in August 2017. The remaining 45% of the FY 2018 monies (\$140,949) and a portion of the FY 2019 monies (\$174,966 or 55%) were released in July 2018. The FDEP decided not to request the remaining 45% of the FY 2019 monetary award amount (\$143,154) that was scheduled to be released in June 2019 and will continue to conduct work utilizing the current total budget amount of \$488,186. The rejection of additional funds was attributable to a slower-than-normal start to FY19 sitework due to the inability to obtain Site Access Agreements (SAA) with property owners/responsible parties, as well as an unexpected government shutdown which put a halt on required reviews by EPA staff.

II. Status of Staff

There were two staff changes during the 3rd Quarter of FY 2019. Carrie Kruchell (Environmental Manager) and Hope Cates (ESIII) departed the program on June 28, 2019. The vacant position (ESIII) that was reported in the 2nd Quarter Report remains unfilled. **Table 1** (below) gives an overview of current and anticipated CSS staff as of the date of this report.

VI. Other Tasks in Support of Assessment Activities

Keith (Billy) McClain, Office Automation Specialist for CSS, prepares Geographic Information System maps and generates tables for CSS deliverable reports. However, his position is funded under a separate source and not included in the "others" category. **Table 5** presents the total hours spent for all other assessment functions including, but not limited to, technical assistance, training, public requests, workshops, quarterly EPA reports, work plan amendments, fiscal tracking, geology boilerplates, EPA backlog sites, public inquiries and complaints, and out-of-state travel for meetings and trainings (when approved).

VII. Budget

As stated earlier in Section I, the total approved funding award for the current CA (V-00D57717) was \$631,340; however, the FDEP decided not to accept the final allotment amount of \$143,154 based upon the inability to utilize those additional funds as discussed earlier in this report. As of June 30, 2019, \$103,059.81 remains in the CER17 overall grant budget.

The details of the budget and expenditures as of June 30, 2019, are provided in **Table 6**.
