Subject: Guidance on Air Permit Application Processing Offices

To provide statewide consistency and best allocate permitting resources, air permit applications will be processed by the following offices as of January 1, 2018:

Major Source Preconstruction Review for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) of Air Quality • Non-attainment Areas 	DARM-OPC
All applications for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Air General Permits • Acid Rain Sources • Electric Utilities • Waste-to-Energy Plants/Municipal Waste Combustors • Portland Cement Plants • Pulp and Paper Mills • Phosphate Fertilizer Plants* • Sugar Mills and Refineries 	DARM-OPC
All air permit applications within the jurisdiction of the Approved Local Program except for permits for county-owned facilities, those permit types processed by DARM-OPC, and permits for major sources belonging to Major Group 28, Chemicals and Allied Products, as defined in the Standard Industrial Classification Manual	Local Program
All air permit applications within the District (including for county-owned facilities) except for those processed by the Approved Local Program and those permit types processed by DARM-OPC	District

* DARM-OPC will work with affected District offices and Approved Local Programs to gradually assume responsibility for Phosphate Fertilizer Plant permits during calendar year 2018.
