## Who should file this claim form?

All owners or operators of petroleum storage systems who are enrolled in the Florida Petroleum Liability and Restoration Insurance Program (**FPLRIP**) and have discovered petroleum product contamination from a discharge of an eligible petroleum storage system should complete this form and send to:

Completion of this form is necessary to file a claim under **FPLRIP**. Submission of this form does not guarantee that you will receive state assistance.

## Instructions to complete the FPLRIP claim form:

Fill in the DEP facility ID number. Only registered sites enrolled in **FPLRIP** are eligible.

Fill in the date of discovery of the discharge that you are seeking FPLRIP eligibility.

Fill in the name and physical address of the facility.

Fill in the name and mailing address of the storage tank owner or operator.

Fill in the name and mailing address of the real property owner, if different.

Fill in storage tank owner/operator and real property owner phone numbers and email address, if different.

Fill in the financial responsibility type:

- A) FPLIPA/State Fund
- B) Self Insured/State Fund
- C) Other Insurance/State Fund
- **D**) Other method. Explain.

Check the method of cleanup desired for site remediation.

Circle the answer to each item that applies relative to compliance with Section 376.3072, F.S. For each "yes" answer please provide supporting documentation.
