Project sponsors may select a match ratio of 100:0 of Part III, Financial Information.	• True

<i>False; sponsor match is both a federal and state requirement for RTP projects. Applicants may select either a 50:50, 60:40 or 80:20 match ratio. See slide 42 for additional information.</i>

There is no required supporting documentation for the RTP Application.	• True

<i>False; while some supporting documentation is elective to receive additional points, many documents are required to compete for funding, such as the boundary map, site control, and conceptual site plan. See slides 45-62 for additional information.</i>

Project sponsors must respond to an issued Deficiency Report within 15 calendar days or the submitted application will be ineligible to compete for funding.	• True
