Guiding Principles for The Meeting

- 1. **Meeting Parameters** –To ensure that the Ranking and Selection meeting is conducted in a manner that is fair to all applicants, the following parameters have been set for all presentations:
- 2. **Review of FF21 Applications** Applications will be reviewed in project number order for eligible projects, then by withdrawn projects, followed by ineligible projects. Review is subject to changes in sequence at the discretion of the Governing Board.
 - a. **FCT Staff Presentations** Staff will present recommended scores for each project application.
 - b. Applicant Objections to Point Score Each applicant has up to <u>five (5) minutes</u> to address any unresolved issues or objections to Staff recommended scores. (FCT Staff will give presenter and Chairman time warnings). Applicant objections to Staff recommended scores were required to be submitted in writing to Trust Staff at least <u>5</u> <u>working days</u> prior to the July 27th meeting, in order to be considered by the Board. No new information shall be presented to, or considered by, the Governing Board at this point. By FCT Program Rule, evaluation of the application is based on the information contained in the application when it was submitted.
 - i. **Governing Board discussion** The Governing Board may ask additional questions of applicants and Staff.
 - c. **Scoring Consideration** The Governing Board will vote to either uphold Staff recommendation or to accept applicant objection information for the awarding of additional points.
 - d. **Applicant Presentation** Each applicant is limited to a maximum of <u>five (5) minutes</u> to present their project to the Governing Board. (FCT Staff will give presenter and Chairman time warnings). Applicant comments should only address requests for the awarding of additional Project Excellence points.
 - i. **Governing Board Discussion** The Governing Board may ask additional questions of applicants and Staff.
 - e. **Scoring Consideration** The Governing Board will make the final applicant score determination, including the awarding of project excellence points, if any. The Governing Board will clearly state the basis for the awarding of project excellence points.
- Calculation of Scores Applicant scores will be calculated, and the preliminary ranking will be created in descending point order. In the event of a tie score, Rule 62-818.008(2)(d) establishes a four-step tie breaking procedure. FCT will apply each of these steps, in order, until the tie is broken.
 - a. Score received in the Community Planning Section.

- b. Score received in the Outdoor Recreation Section.
- c. Score received in the General Standards Section.
- d. The order in which the applications were received.
- 4. Selection for Funding The Governing Board will make a preliminary determination of which applications will be funded for the FF21 Grant Cycle. Following the meeting, FCT Staff will conduct site visits to confirm scores and facilitate preparation of special management conditions. Final scores and ranking will be adjusted accordingly based on the site visits or other investigations. The final ranking list will be approved by the Governing Board at a subsequent meeting and then published in the Florida Administrative Register.
