9/26/29	Preliminary site assessment (PSA) performed. Groundwater, surface water, sediment and soil samples were collected by SIS staff and State contractors.	DEP, Monroe County, State Contractors	The PSA included the collection of 22 soil samples at 11 locations from 0-6" to 6"-2', two sediment samples and two surface water samples. Two temporary monitor wells were installed and sampled.
10/21/19	Certified sample event results received from FDEP Central Laboratory.	DEP, DEP Central Laboratory, DOH, Monroe County Fire Chief	Concentrations of perfluorooctanoate acid (PFOA) and perfluorooctane sulfonate (PFOS) in groundwater were above the Health Advisory Level (HAL) and concentrations of PFOA and PFOS in soil were above provisional soil cleanup target levels. Results sent to DOH, appropriate DEP district and local staff, and Monroe County representatives. DOH requested to conduct nearby potable supply well sampling.
09/14/22		DEP	Based on the passage of HB 1475, the DEP Southeast District office sent an email extending an offer from DEP to continue assessment activities for PFAS with the goal of determining the extent of contamination originating from the fire training facility.

09/27/22		DEP, Monroe County	A Teams meeting with DEP was productive. However, access to complete these activities has not been provided to DEP. The County has already conducted considerable assessment and an excavation. Contaminated soil has been removed; groundwater plume is defined and stable. Based on current P-GCTLs, DEP has determined the site qualifies for RMO III.
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
