RECENT SUCCESSES

Record Number of Closed Discharges

The PRP closed a record 733 eligible discharges in FY 17/18, which exceeded the previous record of 567 in FY 16/17 by almost 30%!

Half of All Eligible Discharges Closed

The PRP also achieved another notable milestone in FY 17/18, having now closed 53% of all eligible discharges!

Sharing Information with Our Contractors

- The PRP has established a Difficult Sites Review Team for sites with anticipated cleanup costs over \$500,000 and/or with difficult technical considerations. Though voluntary, FDEP Site Managers are encouraged to seek review by the committee for difficult sites. - PRP Accounting is now accepting LSSI Work Order Invoices electronically at LSSI_Invoices@dep.state.fl.us. An original or certified signature is required for all signature blocks. Additional details will be posted on the PRP web site soon. Questions (not invoices) should be directed to PRP Accounting at PRP_Accounting@dep.state.fl.us.
- Contractors will soon have the option of submitting their Automated Data Processing Tool (ADaPT) Electronic Data Deliverables (EDDs) using the DEP Enterprise Self Service Authorizations (ESSA) portal in lieu of the PRP FTP site. An updated ADaPT DWM User Guide and several training videos will soon be available on the Division of Waste Management ADaPT web page at <https://floridadep.gov/waste/waste/content/adapt>.
- When submitting a Change Order (CO) for a new task with field work and a deliverable due date later than the current with Contingent Funding, the CO should include moving the unused Contingent Funding amount to the new task for continued use. This move can be performed even if the original task due date has expired.
