Re: Air Program Submittal: Proposed Revision to Florida's State Implementation Plan – Amendment to the Maintenance Plan for the Hillsborough County Lead Maintenance Area

Dear Ms. Walker:

Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. 51.103, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (Department) is submitting a State Implementation Plan (SIP) package to revise Florida's SIP under the federal Clean Air Act (CAA).

This SIP submittal proposes to revise Florida's Maintenance Plan for the Hillsborough County Lead Maintenance Area to incorporate recent permit revisions for the EnviroFocus Technologies, LLC facility. These recent permit revisions increased the permitted refined lead production limit for the facility and incorporated other minor changes associated with the production increase. This SIP submittal also proposes to revise the attainment emissions inventory and projected future emissions inventories.

On December 18, 2019, the Department published in the Florida Administrative Register a notice of opportunity to submit comments regarding this proposed SIP revision, request a public hearing, or participate in a public hearing on January 21, 2020, if requested. No hearing was requested, and no hearing was held. This process met the public participation requirements of 40 C.F.R. 51.102.
