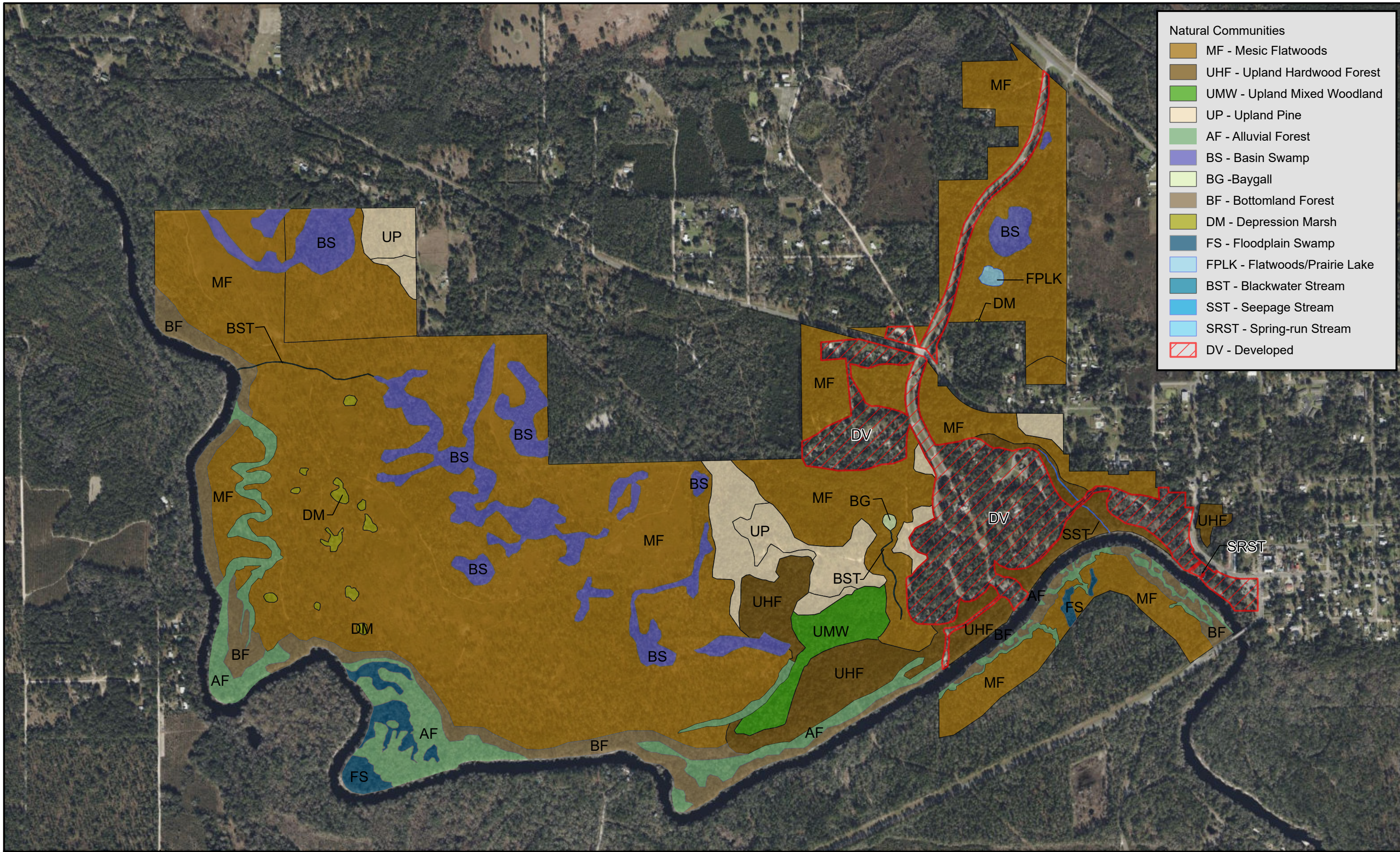

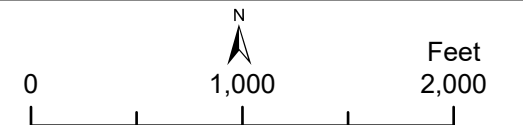

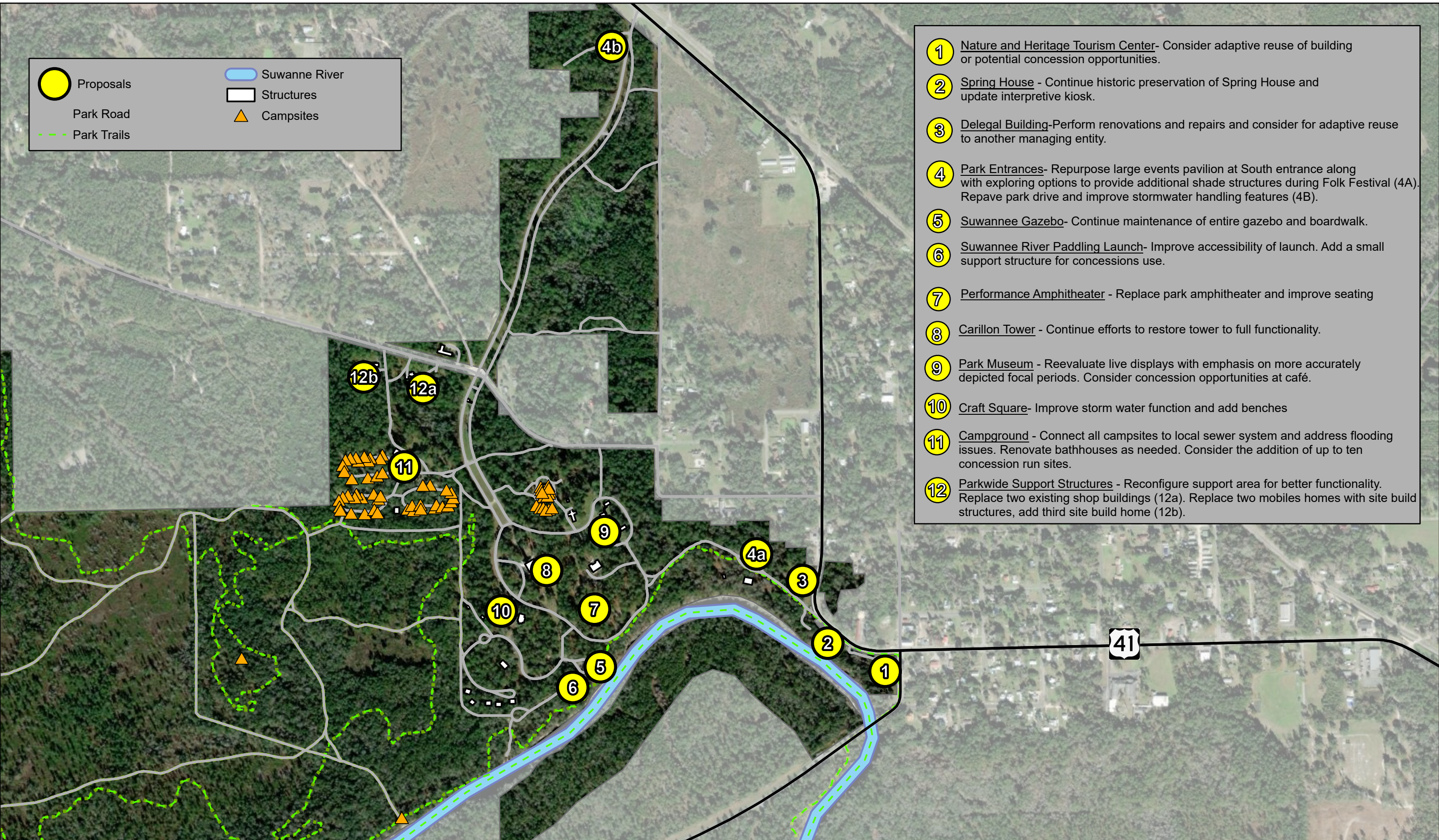

- 1** Nature and Heritage Tourism Center- Consider adaptive reuse of building or potential concession opportunities.
- 2** Spring House - Continue historic preservation of Spring House and update interpretive kiosk.
- 3** Delegal Building-Perform renovations and repairs and consider for adaptive reuse to another managing entity.
- 4** Park Entrances- Repurpose large events pavilion at South entrance along with exploring options to provide additional shade structures during Folk Festival (4A). Repave park drive and improve stormwater handling features (4B).
- 5** Suwannee Gazebo- Continue maintenance of entire gazebo and boardwalk.
- 6** Suwannee River Paddling Launch- Improve accessibility of launch. Add a small support structure for concessions use.
- 7** Performance Amphitheater - Replace park amphitheater and improve seating
- 8** Carillon Tower - Continue efforts to restore tower to full functionality.
- 9** Park Museum - Reevaluate live displays with emphasis on more accurately depicted focal periods. Consider concession opportunities at café.
- 10** Craft Square- Improve storm water function and add benches
- 11** Campground - Connect all campsites to local sewer system and address flooding issues. Renovate bathhouses as needed. Consider the addition of up to ten concession run sites.
- 12** Parkwide Support Structures - Reconfigure support area for better functionality. Replace two existing shop buildings (12a). Replace two mobiles homes with site build structures, add third site build home (12b).
